The Bay Path School Council is a representative school building-based committee composed of the principal, parents, teachers, community members and students. The School Council meets a minimum of three times a year. An agenda is provided at each meeting and minutes are recorded. The School Council representatives discuss and determine the school improvement goals based on the mission, philosophy and goals of Bay Path. Specifically, our responsibilities include assisting the principal in these four areas:

- 1) adopting educational goals that are consistent with local educational policies and statewide student performance standards;
- 2) identifying the educational needs of our students;
- 3) reviewing the annual school building budget and;
- 4) formulating a school improvement plan. Progress in these four areas is reviewed and adjusted as needed, given the documentation or timelines which supports the necessity to do so.
